

2022 “I Voted” Sticker Contest

CONTEST RULES AND GUIDELINES

Eligibility

All Salt Lake County 9th to 12th grade students for the 2021-2022 academic year are eligible to enter.

Students may enter as individuals only.

Salt Lake County employees and immediate family may not enter.

Design Guidelines

Artwork may be submitted as an image scan or digital photograph at least 300 dpi in resolution in JPEG, PNG, TIFF, AI, or EPS file formats. Hard copies may also be submitted.

Design must be fully contained within a circle 2.25 inches in diameter. Outline must be circular.

The phrase “I Voted”, or a variation of the phrase, must be included in the design.

Please do not include the year in the sticker design.

All artwork must be non-offensive and acceptable to all audiences.

All artwork must be non-partisan (cannot favor a political party or candidate).

All entries must be an original design, created by the participant. Copyright protected images, graphics, or designs may not be included.

How to Enter

All entries must be submitted on or before Thursday June 30th, 2022.

Only one entry per artist will be accepted.

No Entry will be considered without a fully completed, legible entry form.

For students under age 18, a parent or guardian must complete the release form for the submission to be considered.

Selection, Notification, and Verification of Finalists and Winner

Finalists will be determined by a panel of Salt Lake County Election Division employees, who will review all entries for conformance to the contest rules and evaluate all conforming entries on the following criteria:

- Overall aesthetics or eye-catching ability.
- Clarity, strength, and effectiveness of design.
- Uniqueness of the design in relation to Salt Lake County.

Finalists will be announced the week of July 11, 2022, with advancing artists being notified by email at that time. Residents of Salt Lake County will then select a winner through a countywide online vote of the final entries.

The winner will be announced at a Salt Lake County Council meeting in August, date to be determined. They will be notified by e-mail address provided in the contest entry form.

Incomplete or false information on an entry form may disqualify a contestant.

Winning Entry

The winning design may be used as Salt Lake County's official "I Voted" sticker beginning in November 2022 and for general, primary, and special elections through 2024. Additionally, the winning entry will receive a \$200 gift card, with second and third place entries receiving \$100 and \$50 gift cards, respectively.

Privacy Statement

The Salt Lake County Clerk's office will not sell or otherwise provide information concerning contest participants to companies, organizations or individuals not associated with the office, without first obtaining the express permission of the participant. Protected information includes e-mail addresses, names, street addresses, phone number or other information that participants may provide as a condition to participation in the contest.

Disclaimer and Limits of Liability

Except where prohibited by law, the entry constitutes express permission to use any and all winners' names and designs for promotional purposes.

The Salt Lake County Clerk's office reserves the right to modify the design in order to mass-produce.

All entries become the property of the Salt Lake County Clerk's office for all purposes and will not be returned or acknowledged. The Clerk's office is not responsible or liable for lost, interrupted or unavailable network server or other connection, miscommunications, failed phone or computer or telephone transmissions or technical failure, jumbled, scrambled or misdirected transmissions, or other error of any kind whether human, mechanical or electronic. Incorrect, incomplete, mutilated, multiple, late, and any other types of defective entries will be automatically disqualified.
