

#### Elementary K-6th program : Opera by Children





OBC naturally meets ELA reading, writing, and literacy standards and draws in core topics such as social studies and sciences at all grade levels using all the Fine Arts strands of CREATE, PERFORM/PRODUCE, RESPOND, and CONNECT, in drama, dance, music and art while also utilizing media arts tools. Students create a story for the libretto and the melodies for the score, they design and paint the scenery and

costumes, and create the staging for performance. Professional learning workshops teaching art techniques for large murals and a full day opera creation and arts integration learning workshop allow for participation and credits through MIDAS. <u>Click for informational flier here</u>.

#### Middle School/High School 6th-12th program: Festival Songwriter



Students create a song as a class by selecting their desired genre, the instrumentation, write the lyrics on a core topic from their perspective and create the melody and harmony lines. Two hours total in the classroom with two separate sessions. Then our professional musician takes it to the studio and fully executes the song in a "radio ready" recording, one a karaoke track and one with a vocalist. May use in an assembly performance. Use process in Life skills, Speech, any core class including drama or choir. Click for informational flier here

All grades: School or Class Mural Project







This is an afterschool opportunity or scaled to a classroom activity over a few sessions.
Groups of students may work on a school or classroom mural to be installed and enjoyed.
Panels may be individually sized and set into a collage or one large mural using three 4x8 wood panels where
