LESSON OBJECTIVE

A lesson objective is a specific, measurable statement outlining what students are expected to learn and demonstrate by the end of a lesson. It guides instruction and assessment, ensuring alignment with broader educational goals.

SAMPLE LESSON OBJECTIVES

- SCIENCE: STUDENTS WILL BE ABLE TO EXPLAIN THE PROCESS OF PHOTOSYNTHESIS, INCLUDING THE ROLES OF SUNLIGHT, CARBON DIOXIDE, AND WATER, AND ILLUSTRATE THIS PROCESS THROUGH A LABELED DIAGRAM.
- LANGUAGE ARTS: STUDENTS WILL BE ABLE TO IDENTIFY AND ANALYZE THE MAIN THEME OF A SHORT STORY, PROVIDING EVIDENCE FROM THE TEXT TO SUPPORT THEIR INTERPRETATION.
- MATH: STUDENTS WILL BE ABLE TO SOLVE MULTI-STEP WORD PROBLEMS INVOLVING ADDITION AND SUBTRACTION OF FRACTIONS, DEMONSTRATING THEIR UNDERSTANDING THROUGH WRITTEN EXPLANATIONS AND DIAGRAMS.
