There are so many ways to explore careers and find your path! As part of the human services cluster, West Hills MS College and Career Awareness class learned about nail design.



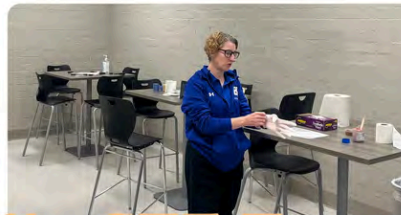

Elk Ridge Middle School 9th graders had the opportunity to tour the CTE programs at Bingham High School.

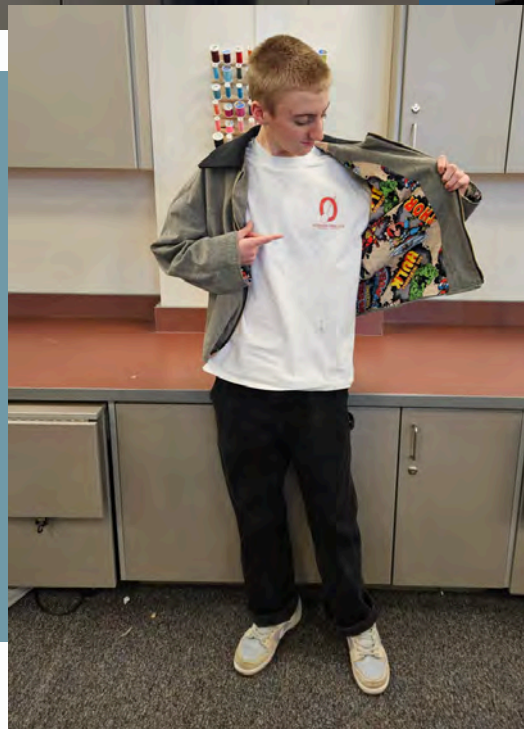
Future Leaders Assembled!

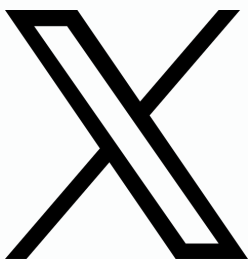
