- ENGL and MATH QL (Math 1050 or Math 2000) courses must have a grade C or higher.
- GPA of 2.7 or higher
- General Education and Pre-program coursework
- Grade of B- or higher in pre-program courses (Math 2010 and 2020 courses C or higher)
- Pass LiveScan Criminal Background Check
- Additional courses that you may not have taken: AUTS 250G, MATH 2010, MATH 2020 (these are math for teachers courses). Contact us ASAP so we can help you take these courses right away.

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
